Encryption Functions

MD5(String s)

Calculates an MD5 checksum for the string.

SHA1(String s)

Calculates an SHA-1 checksum for the string.

SHA256(String s)

Calculates an SHA-256 checksum for the string.

SHA384(String s)

Calculates an SHA-384 checksum for the string.

SHA512(String s)

Calculates an SHA-512 checksum for the string.

DSA(Number size)

Generates a [DSA](#) key pair of the given size.

RSA(Number size)

Generates a [RSA](#) key pair of the given size.

EC(Number size)

Generates a [Elliptic Curve](#) key pair of the given size.

<Digest>with<Encryption>Sign(Object o,String key)

Computes a signature for the given object with the given private key using the given message digest with the given signature algorithm.

SELECT SHA256withRSASign("Hello World", "30820154020100300D...") FROM Stream
=> 51DC22BAFD51B112C72...
```

Example

```
SELECT SHA256withRSAVerify("Hello World", "51DC22BAFD51B112C72...",  
"305C300D06092A8648...") FROM Stream  
=> true
```
